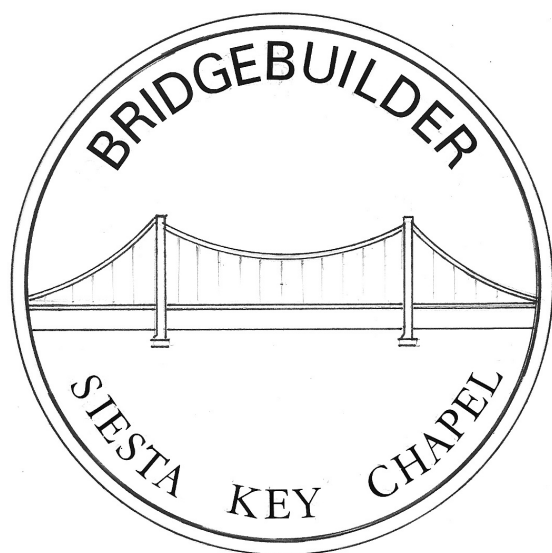

LOOKING FORWARD

In early 2011, Siesta Key Chapel committed to this “way” by creating the **Siesta Key Chapel Endowment Fund**. The purpose of this fund is to receive and invest gifts in a responsible manner so as to preserve and grow the gift, while at the same time generating and distributing annual income to support the ministry and mission of Siesta Key Chapel.

Your gifts to this Endowment Fund will leave a permanent legacy, ensuring the stability of our ministry. Gifts will also help to develop new outreaches and programs which are currently unobtainable within the scope of our annual budget.

The Endowment Fund will consist of co-mingled gifts, which will be managed for long term growth as well as annual income. In addition to cash and securities, appropriate non-liquid assets may be gifted to the *Fund*. They will be managed responsibly until such time they can prudently be converted to cash for investment.
