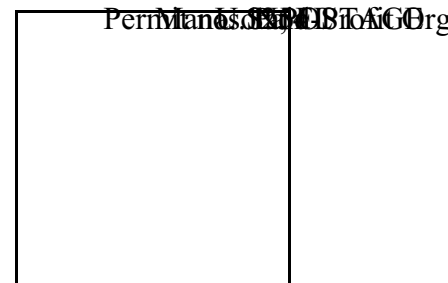

Clive Staples Lewis was and is, a rare gift to this world. Born in Belfast, Ireland in 1898 he died the day President John F. Kennedy was assassinated. His theologically-charged fiction, especially *The Chronicles of Narnia*, and *Screwtape Letters* continue to thrill the imagination while more direct works like *Mere Christianity* continue to build up Christians.
